# 2025 ACET Student Scholarship Rubric

## Eligibility Criterion:

- Attend a public school district or charter school
- On target to be a 2025 high school graduate
- Participation in compensatory educational programs (such as tutoring, mentoring, pregnancy-related services, services to students experiencing homelessness or after-school academic assistance)
- Demonstrated commitment to improving academic skills through engagement in such programs

## Narrative Prompts (≤500 words each):

1. *Tell us your story. What unique opportunities or challenges have you experienced throughout your high school career that have shaped who you are today? **AND***
2. *In what ways would a college degree or postsecondary certification change your life, and in turn, the lives of your loved ones and others around you? The essay should show a sincere desire to further your education for continued self-growth, why you need this scholarship, educational goals, expressiveness, and clarity.*

## Personal Story: Unique Challenge/Opportunities

(35 Points)

<b>Expressiveness &amp; Clarity</b> (5 Points)

Essay is largely incoherent or very difficult to understand.	Essay is difficult to follow due to unclear language or lack of structure. Frequent errors in grammar or mechanics hinder understanding.	Ideas are mostly clear but may have occasional unclear or disjointed sections. Errors in grammar or mechanics may cause minor difficulty in understanding.	Essay is easy to understand, with clearly expressed ideas. Some minor errors in grammar or mechanics may be present but do not hinder understanding.	

**Notes:**

- Writing mechanics (grammar, spelling, etc.) should not heavily impact the score, as the focus is on content, sincerity, and personal circumstances.
