#### 1972-73

41 public school people established the Texas Association for Compensatory Educators (TACE).



The origins of ACET began in the fall of 1972. Charles Thornal, Bea Smith, Dr. Roscoe Smith and Mike Lehr attended a federal programs workshop in Washington, DC, when they came up with the idea for a state organization for compensatory education.



1974

ACET held it's 1st conference in the spring of 1974.



1978

ACET had 350 members!

Bea Smith, ACET's 2nd President (1976-1978) also served as the first Vice-President of NAASFEP in 1974, NAASFEP later became NAFEPA. Bea Smith was a former budget officer for the City of Houston and spent 25 years as a teacher, principal, and administrator for Houston ISD. Upon her retirement, the mayor of Houston declared August 11, 1978 as Beatrice M. Smith Day in the City of Houston.
